Trends in Cell Biology is among the leading review journals in molecular and cell biology. Each month, it publishes review articles that capture the breadth and depth of current research, highlighting new developments as they emerge while integrating various methods, disciplines, and principles. In a 30-minute presentation led by editor Ilaria Carnevale, attendees will be introduced to the Cell Press family of journals, with a particular focus on Trends in Cell Biology. The discussion will cover the pre-submission process, emphasizing critical points to consider, including the importance of crafting an effective cover letter and writing a compelling abstract. Additionally, the presentation will outline the life cycle of a Review article at Trends in Cell Biology, from the initial idea through planning, writing, and revising based on feedback. Key take-home messages will provide valuable best practices for authors looking to create impactful reviews that contribute meaningfully to the scientific community. This session aims to provide attendees with valuable insights and resources to enhance their understanding of the publication process.
